- Aug 20** Today is a busy day, as we visit Skagway, between 8:00 AM and 1:00 PM and Haines between 3:00 PM and 9:00 PM.
- Aug 21** Today is a sea day, so we can take advantage of all the facilities of Silver Shadow. A spa treatment may sound like a good idea. Tonight, the highlight of our wine program features Washington Cabernet Sauvignon and Bordeaux blends. We will taste a good number of wines from the best vintages of the top producers, such as Leonetti, Quilceda Creek and Andrew Will.

- Aug 23** Disembark Silver Shadow.

Air fare from your home city, including a pre-cruise overnight hotel stay at the Four Seasons Vancouver and transfers from the airport to the hotel, and to the ship from the hotel are available from Silversea for \$970-\$1,147 per person, depending on your departure city.

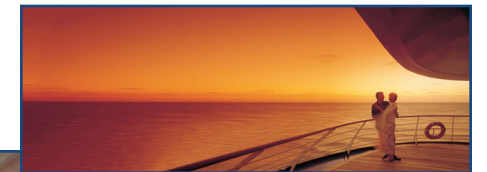
A three night package in Vancouver, also staying at the Four Seasons, including breakfasts, taxes, transfers, and portage is available. This package includes a half-day tour. Other tours will also be available from the Silversea hospitality desk at the Four Seasons. \$385 per person for guests purchasing air from Silversea, or \$720 for cruise only passengers.

A three night Seattle Package at the Four Seasons Olympic hotel is also available. Again, a half day tour of the city is included as are transfers, service, taxes and breakfasts.
